This funding will be used to

Improve student achievement in Mathematics, Reading and Writing, resulting in:

- Improvement and increase in the percentage of students achieving at National Minimum Standard in Years 3 and 5 in the areas of Reading, Writing and Number (from 2019);
- Improvement and increase in the percentage of students achieving in the Upper Two Bands in Years 3 and 5 in the areas of Reading, Writing and Number (from 2019);
- Improvement in the percentage of students achieving at a B or A standard in English and Mathematics. (Sem 2)

Our initiatives include

Improving pedagogy by:

- Continuing the implementation of school-based coaching model to improve teacher capacity in the explicit instructional model and rigorous reading;
- Teaching teams being released every week to analyse student achievement data and determine responses to benefit students.

Enhancing quality curriculum by:

- Embedding a Guaranteed and Viable curriculum approach in the area of Mathematics, embedding proficiency scales from P- 6;
- Ensuring the Australian Curriculum is implemented with integrity.

Delivering whole school approach to differentiated teaching and learning by:

- Continuing additional learning support through employment of an additional teacher and teacher aide time;
- Continuing implementation of Multi-Lit across P-6.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employment of additional teaching staff to create additional STLN role and Head of Department (Curriculum) \$183,749
- Employment of additional teacher aide support to support intervention programs - \$80,000
- Teacher release for the development of Guaranteed and Viable Curriculum - \$33,661
